SHE might describe herself as a "Murri from Cairns" but Terri Janke's story has been deemed remarkable enough to be included in a new book profiling inspirational Australian women.

Author Karen Phillips chose Terri as one of 50 women to feature in Women's Words of Wisdom, Power & Passion.

The book shares the experiences of leading women from athlete Cathy Freeman to model Miranda Kerr.

Now living in Sydney, Terri is a lawyer at her own firm which specialises in representing indigenous artists and creators.
